### Fever Triads

Pneumonia	Fever Cough with expectoration Dyspnea
Meningitis	Fever Headache Neck stiffness
Acute encephalitis	Fever Headache Altered mental status
Brain abscess	Fever Headache Focal neurologic deficit
Murphy's triad in Acute appendicitis	Fever Right lower quadrant abdominal pain Vomiting
Acute cholecystitis	Fever Right upper quadrant abdominal pain / tenderness (Murphy's sign) Nausea/vomiting
Charcot's triad in ascending cholangitis	Fever with rigor Right upper quadrant abdominal pain Jaundice
Acute pyelonephritis	Fever with chills Costovertebral angle tenderness (Murphy's punch sign) Nausea/vomiting
Urinary tract infection	Fever Chills & rigor Burning micturation
Spinal epidural abscess	Fever Back pain Neurological deficit

Psoas muscle abscess	Fever Flank pain Limited hip movement
Dengue	Fever Headache Purpuric skin rash
Chikungunya	Fever Erythematous morbilliform rash Joint manifestations
Infectious mononucleosis	Fever Pharyngitis Cervical lymphadenopathy
Chicken pox	Fever Itchy rashes Malaise
Influenza	Fever with chills Rhinitis Sore throat
Tuberculosis	Fever Night sweats Loss of weight
Typhoid	Fever Headache Abdominal pain
Weil's disease (severe form of leptospirosis)	Fever Hepatorenal damage Bleeding manifestations
Scrub typhus	Fever Maculopapular rash Eschar
Brucellosis	Fever Arthritis/arthralgia Hepatosplenomegaly
Infective endocarditis	High grade fever with chills Changing cardiac murmur Positive blood culture
Malaria	Fever with periodic chills Anemia Splenomegaly
