COPD

- 1. Imprecise understanding of the diagnostic testing necessary to establish the diagnosis of COPD and the indication for empiric therapy.
- 2. Lack of clarity on the lab evaluation all COPD patients should have on diagnosis, and the criteria to guide selection of a first therapeutic agent.
- 3. Confusion about types of inhalers and the differences between them.
- 4. Insufficient understanding about indications to stop inhaled steroids in COPD patients.
- 5. Insufficient awareness of end-of-life issues that should be raised for all COPD patients

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
