MONKEY POX

- 1 Orthropox viruses
 - Mostly self limiting
- 2 Spread by contact with infected person
- 3 Incubation period 5-21 days
- 4 PROGRESSION OF INFECTION
 - A. Invasion period fever ,sever headache, *Lymphadenopathy appears before rashes, myalgia and fatigue.
 - B. rashes appears after onset of fever. (begins on face and spreading to trunk and limbs).
 - C. RASHES stage 1) Macules then 2) papules-then 3) vesicles then 4) pustules and lastly 5) crusts. All the rashes will appear on same stage.
- 5. AB INVESTIGATIONS: PCR test from the lession swab.
- 6 TREATMENT:

Symptomatic treatment.

Hydration & supportive rx. 7. Isolation

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
