## Approach to childhood diarrhoea

- 1. Vast majority are viral
- 2. Acute watery diarrhoea associated with URI is viral until proven otherwise
- 3. Use antibiotics only if there is bloody stools
- 4. Only two drugs are recommended for all diarrhoeas WHO ORS & ZINC
- 5. Dose of zinc is 20 mg once a day for 14 days irrespective of age and weight
- 6. Antimotility drugs are contraindicated in children
- 7. Antiamoebics are rarely needed
- 8. Dose of cefixime is 8mg/kg/day BD.
- 9. Breast feeding should never be stopped
- 10. No IM injection

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
