Keraunoparalysis

Lightningstrike affects multiple systems in the body with a myriad of manifestations. Keraunoparalysis is a benign and completely reversible neuroparalysis following a lightning strike. This syndrome is a combination of vascular and neurological manifestations. The involved limbs show neurological symptoms such as total paralysis of the muscles along with varying sensory loss with simultaneous signs and symptoms of vascular insufficiency in the form of pallor, cold, and pulselessness.
